Students will be permitted one re-test in English, reading, or math level after at least a 24-hour waiting period. **ONE additional re-test is permitted no sooner than three months from the oldest valid score date at any course placement testing site.** Course placement scores, with the exception of the reading exemption scores, will be valid for two years from the date of the original or re-test assessment. Note: Not all courses are offered at all college locations. Students should verify that the course they seek is offered at the college they select prior to registration.
