- 3) Explain how you have demonstrated leadership at work, at school, and/or in your community.
- 4) Please describe your past or current community service experiences. This may include but is not limited to on or off campus volunteer activities, service learning, student government, college newspaper, or college clubs.
- 5) What life experiences have shaped who you are today and what challenges have you overcome in achieving your education (i.e. financial, personal, medical, etc.)?
- 6) Share with the scholarship committee a great book you have read and how the messages in this book have motivated or influenced you.
