Program Entry Requirements

Reading Placement Tests

To prove reading comprehension, all prospective EMT students must have one of the Chandler-Gilbert Community College Reading Comprehension assessments listed below:

- EdReady College Reading and Critical Thinking Placement Test with a score of **90 or higher**. EdReady Assessments are taken on the website: <https://maricopa.edready.org/home>
- Next-Generation Accuplacer Reading Assessment with a score of **249 or higher** which can only be taken at a Testing Center
- Accuplacer test score of **74 or above**.
- Students who have a high school GPA of 3.0 or higher are exempt from testing, however, they will need to provide unofficial transcripts at the time of registration.
- Students who have an Associates's Degree or higher from an accredited college are exempt from testing but will need to provide a copy of college transcripts/degree at time of registration.

Age Requirements & Testing

Students must be 17 years of age before taking the NREMT Exam
