- > After acceptance to the program, you will be contacted by the International Education Office to complete pre-departure paperwork and receive advising on available scholarship/financial aid options.
- > After email notification from the IE Office, students must make a \$375 confirmation deposit to secure their space. Deposit will be applied to the program fee. The deposit is non-refundable after the payment deadline of May 8th, 2023. Students with impending financial aid and/or scholarships must provide documentation of payment arrangements to meet financial obligations.
