What can I expect when I visit the Learning Center?

- $\pi$  A supportive, inviting, and friendly learning environment
- $\pi$  Tutors who are courteous, respectful, patient and encouraging
- $\pi$  Tutors who have reasonable knowledge of the subject matter
- $\pi$  Tutors who facilitate my learning but do not do my work for me
- $\pi$  Tutors who seek help if they cannot answer my question
- $\pi$  Tutors who rotate time among students as evenly as possible
- $\pi$  Tutors who suggest additional resources and services

+ As the tutor's role is one of support, ultimate responsibility for all work as to correctness and completeness rests with **ME!**

What is expected of me?

- $\pi$  I come prepared. I bring my assignment, notes, textbook, calculator and am ready to work.
- $\pi$  I ask questions. If I am not sure, I **ask**. If I need help with something in particular, I let my tutor know.
- $\pi$  I allow ample time in my schedule to complete the tutoring process.
- $\pi$  I know that the Learning Center is a supplement to classroom instruction, not a replacement for missed class(es).
- $\pi$  I am respectful of other students and tutors. I keep conversation low, subject matter appropriate and take cell phone calls outside.
